The plan now adopted follows the main lines of the former Catalogue which has received such generous commendation from scholars and librarians, but the endeavour has been to develop it further and embody in this such possible improvements as were suggested during its arrangement and publication. It is hoped, therefore, that this second Catalogue may be found even more comprehensive and fuller in detail than the first, not only extending subjects already included in that but giving many others not found in it. The contents of collected works are placed under their respective subjects instead of merely under the name of the author. Articles contained in periodicals will be found both under the name of the author and under the subject. The purpose being, of course, to set forth all the subjects contained in a book in their various relations, the system of analysis heretofore followed has been even further developed.
